

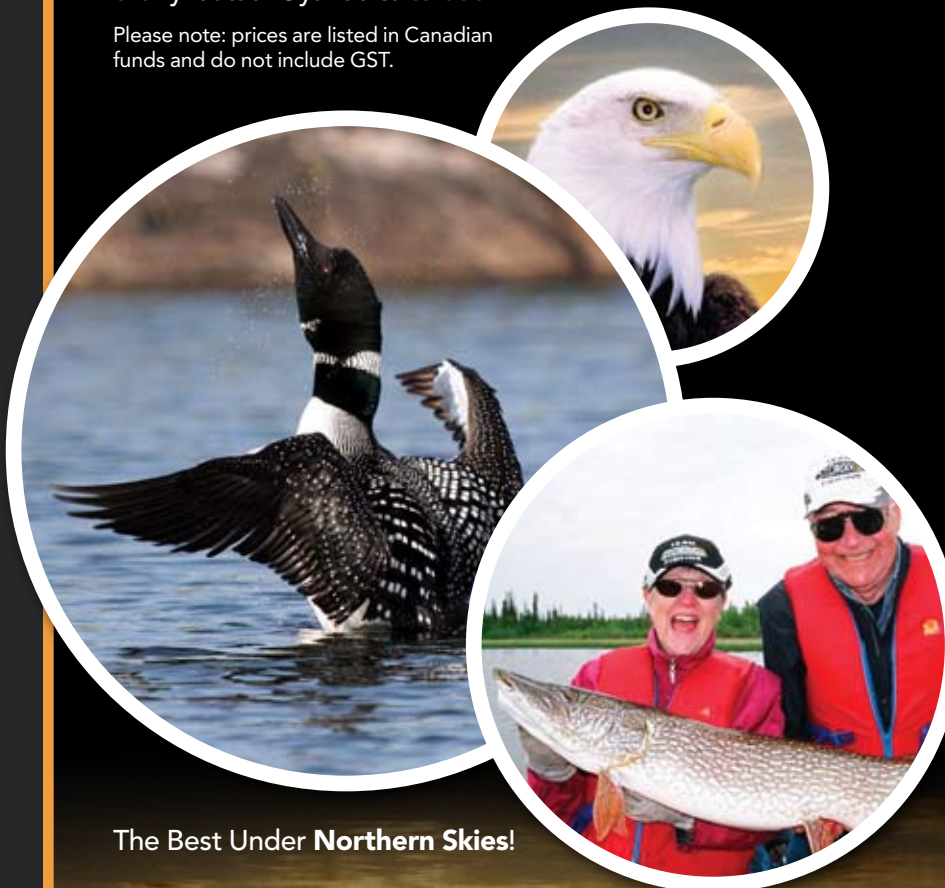

SCHEDULED DEPARTURE TOURS

Dinner on the Wild Side – \$115/person

July 12 6:00 p.m.- 11:00 p.m.

Whet your appetite for Shield Country with a gourmet dinner on the shores of Long Lake in Fred Henne Territorial Park. Dinner on the Wild Side includes a guided natural history tour on the Prospector's Trail and bus transportation to and from the Explorer Hotel.

Great Slave Lake Cruise and Shore Dinner – \$125/person

Your evening cruise begins at the City of Yellowknife's Boat Launch with a leisurely guided tour of Yellowknife Bay on Great Slave Lake. DAY TRIPS

Fishing for Great Northern Pike

No fishing experience required for this adventure! The Northern Pike, a scrappy predator that lurks in these northern waters, is always a thrill to get on your line. Your guide will provide you with all the fishing gear you need and guidance on "catch and release" techniques.

A Great Slave Lake Birding Adventure – \$125/person

Discover the North's avian diversity on this guided boat tour on Great Slave Lake. Guests have an opportunity to see nesting Bald Eagles, Caspian Terns, scoters, loons and more, in and around the myriad of islands dotting Yellowknife's watery front door.

SCENIC FLIGHT TOURS

YK and Beyond – 1 hour dock to dock

Step on board a local float plane to enjoy of a bird's eye view of Yellowknife's skyline and surrounding area. Your tour will fly over Dene communities, the "road to resources", Cameron Falls and Great Slave Lake. Bring your camera!

East Arm Fishing Excursion – 4 hours dock to dock

Fly to the world famous East Arm of Great Slave Lake, soon to be designated as a National Park. Your flight tour includes a 2 hour stop to explore the area's beautiful geology, try your hand at fishing, lounge on a sun warmed rock, and for the brave, a dip in the frigid waters. A delicious shore lunch of fresh fish will be prepared by your guide to round out your visit to the East Arm.

A Visit to Virginia Falls – 10-11 hours dock to dock
